Educational Objectives

- This educational session will provide an overview of the present state-of-the-art PET auto-segmentation (PET-AS) algorithms with an emphasis on understanding the challenges and pitfalls associated with implementing a PET-AS algorithm.
- The different types of PET-AS algorithms will be briefly described and their advantages and limitations will be highlighted. The dependence on application as well as on the scanner and radiotracer used will be discussed.
- The available image datasets and metrics for evaluation of PET-AS algorithms will be introduced. An implementation of some of these image datasets and metrics in a benchmark, which is a candidate for a PET-AS evaluation standard, will be presented.
- A procedure for algorithm acceptance and implementation as well as the complementary role of manual and auto-segmentation will be discussed.
